(1)(b), (1)(c), and (1)(h) or adopt alternative standards based on best practices or industry standards and may contract separately with the Agency for State Technology to provide and perform any of the services and functions for those Departments.

(3) (a) An information technology project administered or implemented by the Department of Financial Services, the Department of Legal Affairs, or the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services is subject to the powers, duties and functions of the Agency for State Technology if such project is expected to have a total project cost of \$50 million or more; and the project directly affects another state agency or another information technology project that is subject to the powers, duties and functions of the Agency for State Technology.

(b) If an information technology project administered by a state agency subject to the powers, duties and functions of the Agency for State Technology must be connected to or otherwise accommodated by an information technology system administered by the Department of Financial Services, the Department of Legal Affairs or the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the Agency for State Technology must consult with those departments regarding the risks and other effects of such projects on those departments' information technology systems and shall work cooperatively with those departments regarding the connections, interfaces, timing or accommodation required to implement such projects.
