5 Between lines 890 and 891, insert:

6 (17) FUNDING.—Students enrolled in a charter school,
 7 regardless of the sponsorship, shall be funded as if they are in
 8 a basic program or a special program, the same as students
 9 enrolled in other public schools in the school district. Funding
 10 for a charter lab school shall be as provided in s. 1002.32.

11 (g) Notwithstanding any provision of this section, a
 12 charter school is required to post a performance bond with the
 13 district school board named as the recipient at the beginning of
 14 each school year in an amount equal to one-half of the projected
 15 operating funds pursuant to paragraph (b). Such bond shall be
 16 annually renewed and shall be invoked if the charter school
 17 defaults on any of its financial obligations with the sponsor.
