At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 2193A, INSERT:

From the nonrecurring funds provided from the Special Employment Security Administration Trust Fund in Specific Appropriation 2193A, \$409,000 is provided for a pilot program to provide employment assistance and training for veterans in Manatee, Sarasota, Hardee and DeSoto counties. The Department of Economic Opportunity must contract with a non-profit organization operating in those counties that recycles materials, operates retail stores, and provides employment opportunities to individuals who may otherwise face barriers to employment. The non-profit organization must have annual gross revenues in excess of \$40
