A bill to be entitled

An act relating to education funding; amending s. 1011.62, F.S.; providing for the calculation of additional full-time equivalent student membership based on enrollment in Advancement Via Individual Determination elective classes and examination scores; providing for the use of funds; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraphs (p) through (u) of subsection (1) of section 1011.62, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs (q) through (v), respectively, and a new paragraph (p) is added to that subsection to read:

1011.62 Funds for operation of schools.—If the annual allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each district for operation of schools is not determined in the annual appropriations act or the substantive bill implementing the annual appropriations act, it shall be determined as follows:

(1) COMPUTATION OF THE BASIC AMOUNT TO BE INCLUDED FOR OPERATION.—The following procedure shall be followed in determining the annual allocation to each district for operation:

(p) Calculation of additional full-time equivalent

- 1. A value of 0.08 full-time equivalent student membership shall be calculated for each student enrolled in an Advancement Via Individual Determination elective class recognized in the Florida Course Code Directory who takes:
- <u>a. An International Baccalaureate course and receives a</u> score of 4 or higher on the subject examination;
- b. An Advanced International Certificate of Education course and receives a score of E or higher on the subject examination;
- c. A College Board Advanced Placement course and receives a score of 3 or higher on the College Board Advanced Placement examination; or
- d. An Algebra or higher-level mathematics course and receives a passing score on the end-of-course examination for students in grades 6 through 8.
- 2. The value shall be added to the total full-time equivalent student membership in basic programs for grades 6 through 12 in the subsequent fiscal year.
- 3. Each school district shall allocate the funds received pursuant to this paragraph to the school whose students generate

the funds. Funds shall be expended solely for the payment of
costs associated with the school's Advancement Via Individual
Determination system, which include annual membership fees;
professional development and training for program coordinators,
teachers, and tutors; instructional supplies and materials; and
compensation for tutors.
