 2           An act relating to education funding; amending s.  
 3           1011.62, F.S.; providing for the calculation of  
 4           additional full-time equivalent student membership  
 5           based on enrollment in Advancement Via Individual  
 6           Determination elective classes and examination scores;  
 7           providing for the use of funds; providing an effective  
 8           date.

 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 12           Section 1. Paragraphs (p) through (u) of subsection (1) of  
 13           section 1011.62, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as  
 14           paragraphs (q) through (v), respectively, and a new paragraph  
 15           (p) is added to that subsection to read:

16           1011.62 Funds for operation of schools.—If the annual  
 17           allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each  
 18           district for operation of schools is not determined in the  
 19           annual appropriations act or the substantive bill implementing  
 20           the annual appropriations act, it shall be determined as  
 21           follows:

22           (1) COMPUTATION OF THE BASIC AMOUNT TO BE INCLUDED FOR  
 23           OPERATION.—The following procedure shall be followed in  
 24           determining the annual allocation to each district for  
 25           operation:

26           (p) Calculation of additional full-time equivalent

27 membership of students enrolled in the Advancement Via  
28 Individual Determination system based on scores on the  
29 International Baccalaureate examination, the Advanced  
30 International Certificate of Education examination, the College  
31 Board Advanced Placement examination, and mathematics end-of-  
32 course examinations for students in grades 6 through 8.-

33 1. A value of 0.08 full-time equivalent student membership  
34 shall be calculated for each student enrolled in an Advancement  
35 Via Individual Determination elective class recognized in the  
36 Florida Course Code Directory who takes:

37 a. An International Baccalaureate course and receives a  
38 score of 4 or higher on the subject examination;

39 b. An Advanced International Certificate of Education  
40 course and receives a score of E or higher on the subject  
41 examination;

42 c. A College Board Advanced Placement course and receives  
43 a score of 3 or higher on the College Board Advanced Placement  
44 examination; or

45 d. An Algebra or higher-level mathematics course and  
46 receives a passing score on the end-of-course examination for  
47 students in grades 6 through 8.

48 2. The value shall be added to the total full-time  
49 equivalent student membership in basic programs for grades 6  
50 through 12 in the subsequent fiscal year.

51 3. Each school district shall allocate the funds received  
52 pursuant to this paragraph to the school whose students generate

53 the funds. Funds shall be expended solely for the payment of  
54 costs associated with the school's Advancement Via Individual  
55 Determination system, which include annual membership fees;  
56 professional development and training for program coordinators,  
57 teachers, and tutors; instructional supplies and materials; and  
58 compensation for tutors.

59 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
