Section 103.011, Florida Statutes, is amended 23 to read: Electors of President and Vice President.-Electors 24 103.011 25 of President and Vice President, known as presidential electors, 26 shall be elected on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in 27 November of each year the number of which is a multiple of 4. 28 Votes cast for the actual candidates for President and Vice

29 President shall be counted as votes cast for the presidential 30 electors supporting such candidates. One presidential elector shall be elected from each congressional district and two 31 32 presidential electors shall be elected at large. The Department 33 of State shall certify as elected the two presidential electors 34 at large of the candidates for President and Vice President who 35 receive the highest number of votes in a majority of the 36 congressional districts and each presidential elector of the 37 candidates for President and Vice President who receives the highest number of votes in the respective congressional 38 39 district. Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 103.021, Florida 40 41 Statutes, is amended to read: 42 103.021 Nomination for presidential electors.-Candidates 43 for presidential electors shall be nominated in the following 44 manner: 45 (1)The Governor shall nominate the presidential electors 46 of each political party. The state executive committee of each 47 political party shall by resolution recommend candidates for presidential electors and deliver a certified copy thereof to 48 49 the Governor before September 1 of each presidential election 50 year. The Governor shall nominate and designate as at large or 51 by district only the electors recommended and so designated by 52 the state executive committee of the respective political party. 53 Each such elector shall be a qualified elector of the party he 54 or she represents who has taken an oath that he or she will vote 55 for the candidates of the party that he or she is nominated to represent. The Governor shall certify to the Department of State 56

57 on or before September 1, in each presidential election year, 58 the names of a number of electors for each political party equal 59 to the number of senators and representatives that which this state has in Congress and shall indicate which electors are at 60 61 large and which electors are for each congressional district. 62 Section 3. Section 103.051, Florida Statutes, is amended 63 to read: 64 103.051 Congress sets meeting dates of electors.-The presidential electors shall, on the day that is directed by 65 Congress and at the time fixed by the Governor, meet at 66 Tallahassee and perform the duties required of them by the 67 68 Constitution and laws of the United States.
