6 Remove lines 402-421 and insert:
 7 application on a form adopted by the commission. The application
 8 must include, at a minimum, the date, time, and location of the
 9 event; the number of additional complimentary tickets for which
 10 the promoter is seeking authorization from the commission; the
 11 percentage of tickets issued for the seats in the house
 12 designated for use in the event for which the promoter is
 13 seeking authorization from the commission; and the persons or
 14 entities that will receive the additional complimentary tickets.

15 (d) The commission, the executive director, or the
 16 executive director's designee shall approve or deny the
 17 application and shall provide the promoter a written explanation

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18 for each approval or denial. The commission, the executive
19 director, or the executive director's designee may set
20 limitations on an approval and may approve all or a portion of
21 the additional complimentary tickets for which the promoter has
22 sought authorization. The commission, the executive director, or
23 the executive director's designee shall provide the promoter a
24 written explanation of any limitation placed on an approval. A
25 denial or approval with limitation by the commission, the
26 executive director, or the executive director's designee is not
27 considered a final agency action and may not be appealed.
