House Resolution

A resolution designating April 1, 2014, as "FSU Day" in the State of Florida.

5 WHEREAS, the main campus of Florida State University in 6 Tallahassee is the oldest continuous site of higher education in 7 Florida and chartered the state's first chapter of Phi Beta 8 Kappa in 1935, and

9 WHEREAS, in 1994, Florida State University joined an elite 10 group of the nation's top research universities, being 11 designated a "Research I" institution by the Carnegie 12 Foundation, and

WHEREAS, Florida State University offers graduate and undergraduate degrees in 314 programs within 16 independent colleges and schools, taught by a faculty of 2,140 members, which has included 13 National Academy of Sciences members and 6 Nobel Laureates, and

18 WHEREAS, the freshman class entering Florida State 19 University in the fall of 2013 was one of the most academically 20 accomplished freshman classes in the university's history, with 21 an average grade point average of 4.0, an average SAT score of 22 1831, and an average composite ACT score of 28, as well as an 23 average high school grade point average of 4.39, an average SAT 24 score of 2,017, and an average composite ACT score of 31, among 25 honors students, and
