House Resolution

A resolution designating April 2, 2014, as "University of Florida Day" in the State of Florida.

5 WHEREAS, in 2014, the University of Florida has continued 6 its legacy of enrolling some of the most academically talented 7 students in the nation, with an average freshman grade point 8 average of 4.4 and an average SAT score of 1960, and

9 WHEREAS, the university launched UF Online in January 2014, 10 the first fully online 4-year bachelor's degree program at a 11 public university in Florida and one of the first such programs 12 offered at a leading national research university, and

WHEREAS, in October 2013, the University of Florida dedicated more than \$13 million in state preeminence funding to hiring new faculty whose work will further 16 university research proposals in fields ranging from computing to biology to business, and

18 WHEREAS, in 2013, the university's Innovation Square 19 continued to draw outside technology companies to establish 20 offices and create jobs in Gainesville, including Mobiquity, a 21 Boston-area mobile application developer, and CurtCo Robb Media, 22 publisher of the Robb Report, and

23 WHEREAS, in 2012, the University of Florida ranked fourth 24 nationally among universities in launching startup companies

25 that used the school's own technologies, a testament to the 26 university's world-renowned faculty, and

27 WHEREAS, the Florida Innovation Hub at the University of 28 Florida contributed to the creation of 250 jobs in its first 20 29 months, and the three-story business superincubator already has 30 more than two dozen tenants, and

31 WHEREAS, in 2013, the University of Florida surged to 32 number 14 among the nation's best public universities as ranked 33 by U.S. News & World Report, a leap forward of three spots from 34 the previous year's standing, and

35 WHEREAS, according to the Wall Street Journal's SmartMoney 36 magazine, the University of Florida offers students and their 37 families the second-highest return on investment of any 38 university in the nation, and

39 WHEREAS, in 2013, the university continued to grow and 40 expand its campus, including completing the Clinical and 41 Translational Research Building, beginning a major renovation 42 and expansion of the Reitz Union, and breaking ground on both 43 Heavener Hall and the Harrell Medical Education Building, and

WHEREAS, in May 2013, the university significantly expanded its scientific research computing capabilities with the completion of HiPerGator, the state's fastest supercomputer and among the top 200 supercomputers in the world, and

48 WHEREAS, the University of Florida continued to unify the 49 six colleges of the UF Health Center and Shands Hospital by 50 bringing them together under one shared brand, UF Health, and 51 WHEREAS, the University of Florida also excels in its 52 student-athletic program, which has been the only program in the 53 nation to rank in the top-ten nationally for the past 30 years 54 and whose athletic victories include 31 national team 55 championships, 213 Southeastern Conference titles, and more than 56 259 individual national titles, NOW, THEREFORE, 57 58 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 59 Florida: 60 That April 2, 2014, is designated as "University of Florida 61 62 Day" in the State of Florida. 63 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be 64 presented to Dr. J. Bernard Machen, president of the University 65 of Florida, as a tangible token of the sentiments expressed 66 herein.
