1 House Resolution 2 A resolution honoring Chester Lee Davis, Sr., in 3 memoriam, for his patriotic service to the United States during World War II. 4 5 6 WHEREAS, Chester Lee Davis, Sr., was born on November 25, 7 1923, in Quincy, Florida, and passed away in 1981 at the age of 8 57, and 9 WHEREAS, on June 25, 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt issued an executive order to establish the Fair Employment 10 11 Practices Commission, opening the doors for the first African Americans to enlist in the United States Marine Corps, and 12 WHEREAS, in 1943, Chester Lee Davis, Sr., was accepted into 13 the Marine Corps among its first African-American recruits, 14 15 completing his basic training at Montford Point in North 16 Carolina, and WHEREAS, Chester Lee Davis, Sr., bravely fought in World 17 18 War II to defend his country, despite the fact that it did not 19 yet offer basic civil rights for African Americans, and 20 WHEREAS, on November 23, 2011, President Barack Obama 21 signed a resolution to posthumously award the Congressional Gold Medal, the highest civilian award from the United States 22 23 Congress for distinguished contributions, to the members of the 24 Montford Point Marines, and
