House Resolution 1 2 A resolution designating April 2014 as "Rare Disease Month" in the State of Florida. 3 4 5 WHEREAS, thirty million, nearly one in ten, Americans are 6 living with a rare disease, which is defined as a disease that affects fewer than 200,000 Americans, and 7 8 WHEREAS, there are approximately 6,800 rare diseases recognized by the National Institutes of Health, one-half of 9 which affect children, and 10 11 WHEREAS, because of their rarity, it is difficult to 12 identify, understand, and treat rare diseases, creating numerous 13 challenges for patients and families affected by the diseases, 14 and 15 WHEREAS, in the decade prior to the passage of the Orphan 16 Drug Act of 1983, only 10 pharmaceutical treatments were 17 developed to treat rare diseases, and 18 WHEREAS, today, more than 450 pharmaceutical treatments for 19 rare diseases are in development, and the United States Food and 20 Drug Administration and the National Institutes of Health have 21 offices solely focused on the treatment of the diseases, and WHEREAS, a number of Floridians live with a rare disease, 22 23 and the citizens of this state stand to support them and their 24 families, NOW, THEREFORE, 25 Page 1 of 2
