House Resolution

A resolution recognizing May 17, 2014, as "Armed Forces Day" in the State of Florida.

5 WHEREAS, the United States military has steadfastly 6 protected this nation during times of war and peace since its 7 inception, and

8 WHEREAS, the United States Army, Navy, and Marine Corps 9 were established in 1775 in concurrence with the American 10 Revolution, followed by the Coast Guard in 1790 and the Air 11 Force in 1947, and

WHEREAS, the United States Armed Forces have bravely fought 12 for and defended the freedom of our country with remarkable 13 14 displays of sacrifice and dedication in the American Revolution, 15 the War of 1812, the Mexican-American War, the Civil War, the 16 Spanish-American War, World War I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Persian Gulf War, Operation Iraqi Freedom, 17 18 Operation Enduring Freedom, the Global War on Terrorism, and 19 countless other campaigns, and

20 WHEREAS, the United States traditionally celebrated Army 21 Day, Air Force Day, Coast Guard Day, Marine Corps Day, and Navy 22 Day to honor those who served in each branch until August 31, 23 1949, when Secretary of Defense Louis Johnson announced the 24 creation of "Armed Forces Day," combining the separate

25 recognitions into a single-day celebration for all branches of 26 the Armed Forces, and 27 WHEREAS, in his Presidential Proclamation on February 27, 1950, President Harry S. Truman declared that the first Armed 28 29 Forces Day would be observed on Saturday, May 20, 1950, stating 30 that "it is fitting and proper that we devote one day each year 31 to paying tribute to the Armed Forces as the servants and 32 protectors of our Nation," and 33 WHEREAS, Armed Forces Day is celebrated annually on the 34 third Saturday of May as a part of Armed Forces Week, which begins on the second Saturday of May and ends on the third 35 36 Sunday of May, and 37 WHEREAS, Armed Forces Day honors former and current United 38 States Armed Forces servicemembers who have kept America safe 39 and free for over 239 years, NOW, THEREFORE, 40 41 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 42 Florida: 43 44 That May 17, 2014, is recognized as "Armed Forces Day" in 45 the State of Florida, and the residents of this state are 46 encouraged to proudly join with the nation in celebrating the 47 accomplishments of the United States Armed Forces and honoring 48 the sacrifice of those who have courageously defended our
