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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to transportation services procurement; creating s. 287.0836, F.S.; requiring the Department of Management Services to adopt rules relating to the procurement of certain transportation services; providing requirements for the rules; providing requirements for implementation of the rules; authorizing the department to submit a report to the Legislature; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature encourages the voluntary reduction of regulated pollutants at the lowest possible cost in order to maintain the state's economic and environmental leadership, and

WHEREAS, strategic investments in the transportation sector promise new jobs, new taxable wealth, and overall increased efficiency, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 287.0836, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

287.0836 Sustainable transportation services procurement.-

The department shall adopt rules to implement a sustainable transportation procurement policy. The rules shall address requirements for the procurement of transportation services, including cargo, freight, and package delivery. The

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rules shall provide that each procurement for transportation services require the vendor to disclose how its services will:

- (a) Reduce regulated pollutants from mobile sources used in providing the services, including, but not limited to, cars, light and heavy trucks, aircraft, buses, and locomotives.
- (b) Reduce regulated pollutants from stationary sources used in providing the services.
- (c) Reduce the overall consumption of conventional oil and gasoline from strategic capital investments made by the vendor.
- (d) Stimulate capital investment of new fueling infrastructure that results in the use of more fuel-efficient vehicles.
- (e) Lower the long-term fuel costs of the services by reducing fuel consumption.
- (f) Help achieve the overall environmental objectives of the state in the most cost-effective manner.
- (2) By January 1, 2015, the department shall publish a notice of proposed rule for the rules required by subsection (1).
- (3) In preparing a procurement for transportation services, the department shall give the appropriate weight, in its discretion, to the combined criteria required under subsection (1).
- (4) If the department desires to comment on the combined economic and environmental impacts of implementing this section, the department may submit a written report to the President of
