(c) The victim's need for assistance must be certified by
a certified rape crisis center in this state or by the state
<u>attorney or statewide prosecutor having jurisdiction over the</u>
<u>offense. A victim of human trafficking's need for assistance may</u>
<u>also be certified by a state certified domestic violence center.</u>

(d) The <u>center's</u> center certification must assert that the victim is cooperating with law enforcement officials, if applicable, and must include documentation that the victim has developed a safety plan. <u>If the victim seeking relocation</u> <u>assistance is a victim of a human trafficking offense as</u> <u>specified in s. 787.06(3)(b), (d), (f), (g), or (h), the</u> <u>certified rape crisis center's or certified domestic violence</u>
