The requirements of part II of chapter 408 apply to the provision of services that require licensure pursuant to 33 34 ss. 400.506-400.518 and part II of chapter 408 and to entities licensed by or applying for such license from the Agency for 35 Health Care Administration pursuant to ss. 400.506-400.518. A 36 37 license issued by the agency is required for the operation of a nurse registry. Each operational site of the nurse registry must 38 be licensed, unless there is more than one site within the 39 40 health service planning district for which a license is issued. 41 In such case, a county. If there is more than one site within a 42 county, only one license per county is required. each
