1                   A bill to be entitled  
2           An act relating to intimate apparel; creating s.  
3           501.935, F.S.; prohibiting retail stores from allowing  
4           a customer to try on intimate apparel in the store  
5           unless over clothing or a disposable shield;  
6           prohibiting the sale of intimate apparel that is tried  
7           on in violation of the prohibition; defining the term  
8           "intimate apparel"; providing an effective date.

10   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

11  
12           Section 1.   Section 501.935, Florida Statutes, is created  
13   to read:

14           501.935 Intimate apparel.—A retail store may not allow a  
15 customer to try on intimate apparel in the store unless the item  
16 is tried on over clothing or a disposable shield. If a customer  
17 tries on an item of intimate apparel in violation of this  
18 section, the item is deemed defective, and the retail store may  
19 not sell the item to any other customer. As used in this  
20 section, the term "intimate apparel" includes lower  
21 undergarments, including lingerie, and swimsuit bottoms.

22           Section 2.   This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
