19	by the corporation for at least 1 year. The credit may be taken
20	only once per new employee.
21	(2) The credit under this section is not available for
22	employment of a person who is:
23	(a) Classified as a violent career criminal, habitual
24	felony offender, habitual violent felony offender, or three-time
25	violent felony offender under s. 775.084.
