Delete lines 42 - 51

and insert:

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(5) "Flowback fluid" means a water-based solution that flows back to the surface during or after completion of well stimulation.

<u>(6)</u> "Gas" means all natural gas, including casinghead gas, and all other hydrocarbons not defined as oil in subsection (17) (15).

12	intervention performed by injecting fluids into a rock formation

16	hydrocarbons from the formation into the wellbore. The term does
17	not include routine well cleaning or maintenance that does not
18	affect the integrity of the well or rock formation.
