4 and insert:

> walking condition in its next annual 5-year transportation work program hazard will be corrected and, if so, when correction of the condition will be completed. If the hazardous walking condition will not be included in the state or local governmental entity's next annual 5-year transportation work program, the factors justifying such conclusion must be stated

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in writing to the district school superintendent and the Department of Education regarding a projected completion date.

- (c) State funds shall be allocated for the transportation of students subjected to a hazardous walking condition. However, such hazards, provided that such funding shall cease upon correction of the hazardous walking condition hazard or upon the projected completion date, whichever occurs first.
 - (3) IDENTIFICATION OF HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS.-
- (a) When a request for review is made by to the district school superintendent with respect to a road over which a state or local governmental entity has jurisdiction or the district school superintendent's designee concerning a condition perceived to be hazardous to students in that district who live within the 2-mile limit and who walk to school, such condition shall be inspected jointly by a representative of the school district, and a representative of the state or local governmental entity with that has jurisdiction over the perceived hazardous location, and a representative of the municipal police department for a municipal road, a representative of the sheriff's office for a county road, or a representative of the Department of Transportation for a state road. If the jurisdiction is within an area for which there is a metropolitan planning organization, a representative of that organization shall also be included. The governmental representatives shall determine whether the condition constitutes a hazardous walking condition as provided in subsection (2). If the governmental representatives concur that a condition constitutes a hazardous walking condition as provided in subsection (2), the governing entity with
