27 Finance Program in a manner that ensures that collectively 28 bargained salary schedules for instructional personnel are 29 funded at a level that guarantees a minimum annual starting 30 salary, while maintaining adequate funding for all other 31 education program areas and personnel. 32 (a) For the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the statewide minimum 33 salary for all instructional personnel is \$50,000. By November 1 of each fiscal year thereafter, the Department of Education 34 35 shall calculate an adjusted minimum starting salary for the 36 upcoming fiscal year by increasing the minimum then in force by 37 the rate of inflation for the 12 months before September 1. In 38 making this calculation, the department shall use the Consumer 39 Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers, not seasonally adjusted, for the South Region or a successor index 40 41 as calculated by the United States Department of Labor. 42 Each district school board shall adjust the statewide (b) 43 minimum starting salary calculated by the department by applying the district cost differential as provided in s. 1011.62(2). 44 45 However, application of the district cost differential may not 46 decrease the minimum starting salary in that district below the 47 statewide minimum. 48 Section 2.
