8 1. A craft distillery ~~or licensed distillery~~ may not
 9 sell any factory-sealed individual containers of spirits except
 10 in face-to-face sales transactions with consumers who are making
 11 a purchase of no more than:

12 a. Two individual containers of each branded product;

13 b. Three individual containers of a single branded
 14 product and up to one individual container of a second branded
 15 product; or

16 c. Four individual containers of one branded product.

17 2. Each container sold in face-to-face transactions with
18 consumers must ~~two or fewer individual containers,~~ that comply
19 with the container limits in s. 565.10, per calendar year for
20 the consumer's personal use and not for resale and who are
21 present at the distillery's licensed premises in this state.

22 ~~3.1.~~ A craft distillery must report to the division within
23 5 days after it reaches the production limitations provided in
24 paragraph (1) (b) ~~(1) (a)~~. Any retail sales to consumers at the
25 craft distillery's licensed premises are prohibited beginning
26 the day after it reaches the production limitation.

27 ~~4.2.~~ A craft distillery may not ~~only~~ ship or, ~~or~~ arrange to
28 ship, ~~or deliver~~ any of its distilled spirits to consumers and
29 may sell and deliver only to consumers within the state in a
30 face-to-face transaction at the distillery property. However, a
31 craft distiller licensed under this section may ship, arrange to
32 ship, or deliver such spirits to manufacturers of distilled
33 spirits, wholesale distributors of distilled spirits, state or
34 federal bonded warehouses, and exporters.

36 unlawful to transfer a distillery license for a distillery that
