99 Section 3. Subsection (1) of section 322.12, Florida  
100 Statutes, is amended to read:

101 322.12 Examination of applicants.—

102 (1) It is the intent of the Legislature that every  
103 applicant for an original driver license in this state be  
104 required to pass an examination pursuant to this section.  
105 However, the department may waive the knowledge, endorsement,  
106 and skills tests for an applicant who is otherwise qualified,  
107 except for an applicant who provides proof of identity under s.  
108 322.08(2)(c)9. or s. 322.08(2)(c)10., and who surrenders a valid  
109 driver license from another state or a province of Canada, or a  
110 valid driver license issued by the United States Armed Forces,  
111 if the driver applies for a Florida license of an equal or  
112 lesser classification. Any applicant who fails to pass the  
113 initial knowledge test incurs a \$10 fee for each subsequent  
114 test, to be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust  
115 Fund. Any applicant who fails to pass the initial skills test  
116 incurs a \$20 fee for each subsequent test, to be deposited into  
117 the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund. A person who seeks to  
118 retain a hazardous-materials endorsement, pursuant to s.

120 surrendering his or her commercial driver license, if the person

133 Department of Defense, or another acceptable form specified by  
134 the Department of Veterans' Affairs. Until a veteran's license  
135 is next renewed, the veteran may have the word "Veteran" ~~capital~~  
136 ~~"V" designation~~ added to his or her license upon surrender of  
137 his or her current license, payment of a \$2 fee to be deposited  
138 into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund, and presentation  
139 of a copy of his or her DD Form 214 or another acceptable form

151 13, ss. 201-202, and determines that the state is otherwise in
