(a) Notwithstanding s. 45, chapter 2008-176, Laws of Florida, as amended by s. 45, chapter 2014-216, Laws of Florida, and s. 320.08053(1), the department shall develop a Take Stock in Children license plate as provided in s. 320.08053(2) and (3) and this section. The plate must bear the colors and design

approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at

the top of the plate, and the words "Take Stock in Children"

must appear at the bottom of the plate.

(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Take Stock in Children, Inc., principal office in this state to fund its activities, scholarship and mentoring programs, and projects. Take Stock in Children, Inc., shall retain all revenue from the annual use fees until all startup costs for developing and establishing the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, up to 15 percent of the annual use fee revenue may be used for promotion and marketing of the specialty license plate and cause and up to 10 percent of the annual use fee revenue may be used for administrative costs directly associated with the corporation's programs and the specialty license plate.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
