9	may purchase or acquire alcoholic beverages for
10	purposes of resale; specifying that a vendor selling
11	certain alcoholic beverages is not required to be
12	licensed as a distributor; deleting provisions
13	relating to vendor pool buying groups; providing an
14	effective date.

16	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

18	Section 1. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 561.14,
19	Florida Statutes, are amended to read:
20	561.14 License and registration classificationLicenses
21	and registrations referred to in the Beverage Law shall be
22	classified as follows:
23	(2) Distributors licensed to sell and distribute alcoholic
24	beverages <u>for resale</u> at wholesale to persons who are licensed <u>or</u>
25	registered to sell alcoholic beverages. Distributors licensed to
26	sell and distribute wine or distilled spirits shall sell and
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27	distribute such wine or distilled spirits to all persons who are
28	licensed or registered to sell such alcoholic beverages. Subject
29	to s. 561.42(3), (4), and (5), or unless expressly provided
30	otherwise by the Beverage Law, it is unlawful for a distributor
31	to fail or refuse to sell its available wine or distilled
32	spirits in like quantities and prices, and with like delivery
33	services, to a person who is licensed or registered by the
34	division.
35	(3) Vendors licensed to sell alcoholic beverages <u>on which</u>
36	excise taxes have been or will be paid by a distributor at
37	retail only. No vendor shall purchase or acquire in any manner
38	for the purpose of resale any alcoholic beverages from any
39	person not licensed as a vendor , manufacturer, bottler, or
40	distributor under the Beverage Law <u>unless otherwise authorized</u> .
41	Purchases of alcoholic beverages by vendors from vendors shall
42	be strictly limited to purchases between members of a pool
43	buying group for which the initial purchase of the alcoholic
44	beverages was ordered by a pool buying agent as a single
45	transaction. No vendor shall be a member of more than one
46	cooperative or pool buying group at any time. <u>A</u> No vendor <u>may</u>
47	not shall import, or engage in the importation of, any alcoholic
48	beverages from places beyond the limits of the state, and the
49	division may not require a vendor selling alcoholic beverages on
50	which excise taxes are paid by a distributor to be licensed as a
51	<u>distributor</u> .
52	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
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
