Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Subsection (23) of section 394.455, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

9 394.455 Definitions.—As used in this part, unless the10 context clearly requires otherwise, the term:

(23) "Psychiatric nurse" means <u>an advanced</u> a registered nurse <u>practitioner certified under s. 464.012 who has a master's</u> <u>or doctoral degree in psychiatric nursing, holds a national</u> <u>advanced practice certification as a psychiatric mental health</u> <u>advanced practice nurse, has licensed under part I of chapter</u> <u>464 who has a master's degree or a doctorate in psychiatric</u> <u>nursing and 2 years of post-master's clinical experience under</u>

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the supervision of a physician, and performs within the 18 19 framework of an established protocol with a psychiatrist. 20 Section 2. Paragraph (f) of subsection (2) of section 394.463, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 21 394.463 Involuntary examination.-22 23 INVOLUNTARY EXAMINATION.-(2) 24 (f) A patient shall be examined by a physician, a or 25 clinical psychologist, or a psychiatric nurse at a receiving facility without unnecessary delay and may, upon the order of a 26 27 physician, be given emergency treatment if it is determined that 28 such treatment is necessary for the safety of the patient or 29 others. The patient may not be released by the receiving 30 facility or its contractor without the documented approval of a psychiatrist or τ a clinical psychologist τ or, if the receiving 31 32 facility is owned or operated by a hospital or health system, the release may also be approved by a psychiatric nurse or an 33 34 attending emergency department physician with experience in the diagnosis and treatment of mental and nervous disorders and 35 after completion of an involuntary examination pursuant to this 36 subsection. A psychiatric nurse may not approve the release of a 37 patient when the involuntary examination has been initiated by a 38 39 psychiatrist unless the release is approved by the certifying 40 psychiatrist. However, a patient may not be held in a receiving 41 facility for involuntary examination longer than 72 hours. 42 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015. 43 284317 - h0335-strike.docx
