I. Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 – 922237 to Senate Amendment 163134 (body with title)

II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 removes requirement for Dept. of Health to display the required signs in health departments and health clinics and reinserts requirement for emergency rooms to display signage in emergency rooms at general acute care hospitals. List of locations where employers must post signage is reduced to two locations only: a strip club or other adult entertainment establishment, and a business/establishment that offers massage or bodywork services for compensation not owned by a regulated health care profession. Removes requirement for metal signs and removes restriction on DOT to spend no more than \$50K for signs for 2015-16 FY. Retains authority for county ordinance to enforce employer signage violations, with the violation being noncriminal punishable by a \$500 fine.
