Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 383.14, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

9 383.14 Screening for metabolic disorders, other hereditary
10 and congenital disorders, and environmental risk factors.-

(2) RULES.—After consultation with the Genetics and Newborn Screening Advisory Council, the department shall adopt and enforce rules requiring that every newborn in this state shall, prior to becoming 1 week of age, be subjected to a test for phenylketonuria and, at the appropriate age, be tested for such other metabolic diseases and hereditary or congenital disorders as the department may deem necessary from time to

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18 time. The department shall expand statewide screening of 19 newborns to include screening for adrenoleukodystrophy as soon 20 as adrenoleukodystrophy is adopted by the federal Recommended Uniform Screening Panel. After consultation with the Office of 21 22 Early Learning, the department shall also adopt and enforce 23 rules requiring every newborn in this state to be screened for 24 environmental risk factors that place children and their 25 families at risk for increased morbidity, mortality, and other negative outcomes. The department shall adopt such additional 26 27 rules as are found necessary for the administration of this section and s. 383.145, including rules providing definitions of 28 29 terms, rules relating to the methods used and time or times for 30 testing as accepted medical practice indicates, rules relating to charging and collecting fees for the administration of the 31 newborn screening program authorized by this section, rules for 32 processing requests and releasing test and screening results, 33 34 and rules requiring mandatory reporting of the results of tests 35 and screenings for these conditions to the department.

36 37 Section 2: This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
