6 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 383.14, Florida
8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 383.14 Screening for metabolic disorders, other hereditary
10 and congenital disorders, and environmental risk factors.—

11 (2) RULES.—After consultation with the Genetics and
12 Newborn Screening Advisory Council, the department shall adopt
13 and enforce rules requiring that every newborn in this state
14 shall, prior to becoming 1 week of age, be subjected to a test
15 for phenylketonuria and, at the appropriate age, be tested for
16 such other metabolic diseases and hereditary or congenital
17 disorders as the department may deem necessary from time to

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18 | time. The department shall expand statewide screening of
19 | newborns to include screening for adrenoleukodystrophy as soon
20 | as adrenoleukodystrophy is adopted by the federal Recommended
21 | Uniform Screening Panel. After consultation with the Office of
22 | Early Learning, the department shall also adopt and enforce
23 | rules requiring every newborn in this state to be screened for
24 | environmental risk factors that place children and their
25 | families at risk for increased morbidity, mortality, and other
26 | negative outcomes. The department shall adopt such additional
27 | rules as are found necessary for the administration of this
28 | section and s. 383.145, including rules providing definitions of
29 | terms, rules relating to the methods used and time or times for
30 | testing as accepted medical practice indicates, rules relating
31 | to charging and collecting fees for the administration of the
32 | newborn screening program authorized by this section, rules for
33 | processing requests and releasing test and screening results,
34 | and rules requiring mandatory reporting of the results of tests
35 | and screenings for these conditions to the department.

36 | Section 2: This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
