31 exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State
32 Constitution. This exemption applies to such confidential and
33 exempt information held by an agency before, on, or after the
34 effective date of the exemption.

35 (b) Information about the location of a residential
36 facility offering services for adult victims of human
37 trafficking involving commercial sexual activity may be provided
38 to an agency, as defined in s. 119.011, as necessary to maintain

54 involving commercial sexual activity, held by an agency, as
55 defined in s. 119.011, Florida Statutes, be made confidential
56 and exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a),
57 Article I of the State Constitution. The Legislature also finds
58 that it is a public necessity that the exemptions apply to such
59 information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective
