24 Affairs Form Letter 27-333, or its equivalent, issued within the
25 last 12 months in lieu of a certificate of disability.

44 amount of \$1, to be retained by the issuing agency. If the
45 person submits with the application a police report documenting
46 that the permit was stolen, there is no replacement fee. A
47 veteran who has been previously evaluated and certified by the
48 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or any branch of
49 the United States Armed Forces as permanently and totally
50 disabled from a service-connected disability may provide a
51 United States Department of Veterans Affairs Form Letter 27-333,
52 or its equivalent, issued within the last 12 months in lieu of a
53 certificate of disability.
