A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program; amending s. 1002.53, F.S.; revising provisions relating to calculation of the kindergarten readiness rate for Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program providers and schools; amending s. 1002.67, F.S.; requiring the administration of a preassessment and postassessment to students based upon adopted performance standards; providing assessment requirements; requiring the assessments to be administered by certain personnel and during certain time periods; requiring the assessments to be used to calculate the kindergarten readiness rate; amending s. 1002.69, F.S.; requiring the Office of Early Learning to annually report to the State Board of Education certain student growth data; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (5) of section 1002.53, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1002.53 Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program; eligibility and enrollment.—

(5) The early learning coalition shall provide each parent enrolling a child in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program with a profile of every private prekindergarten provider and public school delivering the program within the county where the child is being enrolled. The profiles shall be provided to

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parents in a format prescribed by the Office of Early Learning. The profiles must include, at a minimum, the following information about each provider and school:

(b) The provider's or school's kindergarten readiness rate calculated in accordance with <u>ss. 1002.67 and s. 1002.69</u>, based upon the most recent available results of the <u>preassessment and postassessment and the statewide kindergarten screening.</u>

Section 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and subsection (3) of section 1002.67, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

1002.67 Performance standards; curricula and accountability.—

(1)

- (b) The office shall periodically review and revise the performance standards for the <u>preassessment and postassessment administered under this section and the</u> statewide kindergarten screening administered under s. 1002.69 and align the standards to the standards established by the state board for student performance on the statewide assessments administered pursuant to s. 1008.22.
- (3) (a) Contingent upon legislative appropriation, Each private prekindergarten provider and public school in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program must implement an evidence-based preassessment and postassessment pre- and postassessment that has been approved by rule of the State Board of Education.
- (b) In order to be approved, the $\underline{\text{assessments}}$ $\underline{\text{assessment}}$ must:
- $\underline{\text{1.}}$ Be valid, reliable, developmentally appropriate, $\underline{\text{and}}$ observation-based; $\underline{\text{and}}$

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2. Be developed using norm samples similar to Florida's population of children from birth through age 5;

- 3. Be based upon the performance standards adopted by the department under subsection (1) and be designed to measure student progress on domains which must include, but are not limited to, early literacy, numeracy, and language:
- 4. Be appropriate for English language learners and students with disabilities;
 - 5. Be available in multiple languages;
- 6. Have processes for ensuring the ongoing reliability of the assessments; and
- 7. Be supported by evidence-based professional development programs.
- (c) The <u>preassessment and postassessment</u> pre- and postassessment must be administered by <u>prekindergarten instructors</u> individuals meeting requirements established by rule of the State Board of Education <u>during the first and last 2 weeks of the school-year prekindergarten program or summer prekindergarten program.</u>
- (d) Each parent who enrolls his or her child in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program must submit the child for the preassessment and postassessment.
- (e) The preassessment and postassessment data shall be used in calculating a private prekindergarten provider's and public school's kindergarten readiness rate pursuant to s. 1002.69(5).
- Section 3. Subsection (5) of section 1002.69, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 1002.69 Statewide kindergarten screening; kindergarten readiness rates; state-approved prekindergarten enrollment

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screening; good cause exemption.-

(5) The office shall adopt procedures to annually calculate each private prekindergarten provider's and public school's kindergarten readiness rate, which must be expressed as the percentage of the provider's or school's students who are assessed as ready for kindergarten. The methodology for calculating each provider's kindergarten readiness rate must include student learning gains when available and the percentage of students who meet all state readiness measures. The rates must not include students who are not administered the statewide kindergarten screening. The office shall determine learning gains using a value-added measure based on growth demonstrated by the results of the preassessment and postassessment, pursuant to s. 1002.67, from at least 2 successive years of administration of the preassessment and postassessment. The office shall annually report to the State Board of Education the appropriate level of growth to calculate the kindergarten readiness rate of each Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program provider.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
