Section 1. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (8) of section 322.051, Florida Statutes, to read:
322.051 Identification cards.-
(8)
(c) Upon request by a person who has a developmental disability, or by a parent or guardian of a child or ward who has a developmental disability, and submission of payment and required proof, the department shall issue an identification card exhibiting a capital "D" for a person who has been diagnosed by a licensed physician as having a developmental disability as defined in s. 393.063. Such card shall be issued upon payment of an additional $\$ 10$ fee and submission of proof
