The district school board may adopt purchasing rules 30 to assist with the efficient and effective procurement of goods 31 and services, including online procurement, electronic auction 32 services, and multistate purchasing consortia. As used in this 33 paragraph, the term "electronic auction services" means a 34 procurement conducted on a centralized website using third-party 35 software, jointly managed by an approved vendor and an agency or 36 governmental entity, and using the procurement process set forth in s. 287.057 or other authorized means of obtaining competitive 37 38 prices in an auction environment.

39 Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 1006.27, Florida 40 Statutes, is amended to read:

41 1006.27 Pooling of school buses and related purchases by 42 district school boards; transportation services contracts.-

43 The department shall assist district school boards in (1)44 securing school buses, contractual needs, equipment, and 45 supplies at as reasonable prices as possible by providing a plan 46 under which district school boards may voluntarily pool their 47 bids for such purchases. The department shall prepare bid forms 48 and specifications, obtain quotations of prices and make such 49 information available to district school boards in order to facilitate this service and use electronic auction services, as 50 51 defined in s. 1001.42(12)(i), or other efficient procurement 52 tools and multistate purchasing consortia. 53 boards may also use electronic auction services or other 54 efficient procurement tools for such purchases. District school 55 boards from time to time, as prescribed by State Board of 56 Education rule, shall furnish the department with information 57 concerning the prices paid for such items and the department shall furnish to district school boards periodic information 58 59 concerning the lowest prices at which school buses, equipment, 60 and related supplies are available based upon comparable specifications. 61
