Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause
and insert:

Section 1. Paragraph (k) is added to subsection (2) of
section 934.03, Florida Statutes, to read:

934.03 Interception and disclosure of wire, oral, or
electronic communications prohibited.-

(2)

(k) It is lawful under ss. 934.03-934.09 for a child under
18 years of age to intercept and record an oral communication if

12 the child is a party to the communication and has reasonable
13 grounds to believe that recording the communication will capture
14 a statement by another party to the communication that the other
15 party intends to commit, is committing, or has committed an
16 unlawful sexual act or an unlawful act of physical force or
17 violence against the child.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
