Section 4. Section 1011.78, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1011.78 .—Standard Student Attire School District Incentive Payments.

There is created an incentive payment for school districts that implement a districtwide standard student attire policy in accordance with s. 1001.43(1)(b). Qualified school districts shall receive an award of \$10 per student in kindergarten through grade 8. Before the release of funds, the district school superintendent shall certify to the Commissioner of Education, no later than September 1 each year, that the district school board has implemented a standard student attire

policy in accordance with s. 1001.43(1)(b). The Commissioner shall make payment of awards to school districts in the order in which certifications from the district school superintendents are received. As of June 30 of each year, any funds provided pursuant to this section that have not been disbursed to qualified school districts shall revert to the fund from which they were appropriated pursuant to s. 216.301.

Section 5. For the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the sum of \$10 million in recurring general revenue funds is appropriated to the Department of Education for the purpose of awarding school districts that implement a standard student attire policy in accordance with s. 1011.78, as created in this act.
