Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Delete lines 272 - 285 and insert:

(3) COORDINATED CARE ORGANIZATIONS SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGIES. - The department may work through managing entities shall to develop and implement a plan to create a coordinated regional network of behavioral health service providers. The regional network must offer access to a comprehensive range of services and continuity of care for service delivery strategies 11 12

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that will improve the coordination, integration, and management of the delivery of behavioral health services to people with who have mental illness or substance use disorders. The plan must be developed through a collaborative process between the managing entity and providers in the region. The department shall designate the regional network as a coordinated care organization after the relationships, linkages, and interactions among network providers are formalized through written agreements that establish common protocols for intake and assessment, mechanisms for data sharing, joint operational procedures, and integrated care planning and case management. It is the intent of the Legislature that a well-managed service delivery system will increase access for those in need of care, improve the coordination and continuity of care for vulnerable and high-risk populations, and redirect service dollars from restrictive care settings to community-based recovery services. ======= T I T L E A M E N D M E N T ======== And the title is amended as follows: Between lines 26 and 27 insert: requiring the regional network to offer access to certain services; requiring the plan to be developed in a certain manner; requiring the department to

designate the regional network as a coordinated care organization after certain conditions are met;
