7 (b) Each school district shall measure student learning growth 8 using the formulas approved by the commissioner under paragraph (a), and the performance level standards adopted by the state 9 board under subsection (8), for courses associated with the 10 statewide, standardized assessments administered under s. 11 12 1008.22 no later than the school year immediately following the year the formula is approved by the commissioner. For grades and 13 subjects not assessed by statewide, standardized assessments but 14 15 otherwise assessed as required under s. 1008.22(6), each school district shall measure student performance of students using a 16 methodology determined by the district. 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18 provide models for measuring performance of students which 19 school districts may adopt.

20 (c) For a course that is not measured by a statewide, 21 standardized assessment, a school district may request, through the evaluation system approval process, to use a student's 22 23 achievement level rather than student learning growth if 24 achievement is demonstrated to be a more appropriate measure of 25 classroom teacher performance. A school district may also 26 request to use a combination of student learning growth and 27 achievement, if appropriate.

(d) For a course that is not measured by a statewide, standardized assessment, a school district may request, through the evaluation system approval process, that the performance evaluation for the classroom teacher assigned to that course include the learning growth of his or her students on one or more statewide, standardized assessments. The request must clearly explain the rationale supporting the request.

35 (c) For purposes of this section and only for the 2014-2015 school year, a school district may use measurable learning 36 37 targets on local assessments administered under s. 1008.22(6) to evaluate the performance of students portion of a classroom 38 39 teacher's evaluation for courses that are not assessed by statewide, standardized assessments. Learning targets must be 40 41 approved by the school principal.
