327.02 Definitions.—As used in this chapter and in chapter 328, unless the context clearly requires a different meaning, the term:

(9) "Developed waterfront property" means any upland property bounded on at least one side by the waters of the

- state, above the mean high water mark of the shoreline or seawall, upon which a single-family home, multi-family apartment, townhouse, condominium, or other similar residential dwelling exists. The term does not include docks and other infrastructure adjacent thereto or properties with mixed residential and commercial use.
- (41) "Safe harbor" means taking refuge by temporarily anchoring, mooring, or docking due to a mechanical breakdown or when imminent or existing extreme weather conditions impose an unreasonable risk of harm.
- Section 2. Section 327.4107, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

Between lines 39 and 40, insert:

- (6) The anchoring or mooring of a vessel other than liveaboard vessels on the waters of this state may be regulated only as provided in this chapter and chapter 403.
- (7) (a) An owner, operator, or person in charge of a vessel may not anchor or moor a vessel within 200 feet of the marked boundary of a permitted mooring field, any public boat ramp, hoist, marine railway, or other launching or landing facility available for use by the general public.
- (b) An owner, operator, or person in charge of a vessel may not anchor or moor a vessel within 200 feet of a dock between the times of one hour past sunset and one hour before sunrise except as follows:

- 4. Construction or dredging vessels while on an active job site.
  - 5. Vessels actively engaged in commercial fishing.
- 6. Vessels engaged in recreational fishing whereby persons onboard are actively tending hook and line fishing gear or nets.
- 7. Vessels present for the duration of events as described in s. 327.48.
