Remove lines 45-58 and insert:

Section 2. (1) By December 31, 2015, the Department of Veterans' Affairs, through a direct-support organization under s. 292.055, Florida Statutes, and in consultation with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, shall create a section on agriculture and farming opportunities in the state for veterans of the United States Armed Forces to be included in the 2016 and 2017 Florida Veterans' Benefits Guides. The section must include, at a minimum, information on federal, state, and local agriculture and farming incentives, assistance, grants, and outreach and advocacy programs available to veterans.

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- (2) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall make the benefits guide available to all military installations in the state and provide a consolidated description of and link to the agriculture and farming opportunities section on its website.
- (3) This section shall not be codified in the Florida Statutes.

Remove lines 71-81 and insert:

Safety and Motor Vehicles and the Department of Military Affairs shall jointly conduct a pilot program to provide onsite commercial driver license testing opportunities to qualified members of the Florida National Guard pursuant to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles commercial driver license skills test waiver under s. 322.12. Testing must be held at a Florida National Guard Armory, an Armed Forces Reserve Center, or the Camp Blanding Joint Training Center. The pilot program shall be accomplished using existing funds appropriated to each department.

- (2) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and the Department of Military Affairs shall jointly provide a report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives providing the results of the pilot program by June 30, 2017.
 - (3) This section is repealed October 1, 2017.
- (4) This section shall not be codified in the Florida Statutes.

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
