46 (1) A municipal park or recreation department shall
 47 provide a partial or full discount on park entrance fees to an
 48 individual who presents information satisfactory to the
 49 municipal department that the individual is:

50 (a) A current member of the United States Armed Forces,
 51 their reserve components, or the National Guard.

52 (b) An honorably discharged veteran of the United States

53 Armed Forces, their reserve components, or the National Guard.

54 (c) A veteran of the United States Armed Forces, their
 55 reserve components, or the National Guard, who has a service-
 56 connected disability as determined by the United States
 57 Department of Veterans Affairs.

58 (d) A surviving spouse or parent of a deceased member of
 59 the United States Armed Forces, their reserve components, or the
 60 National Guard, who died in the line of duty under combat-
 61 related conditions.

62 (e) A surviving spouse or parent of a first responder, as
 63 defined in s. 112.1815, who died in the line of duty.

64 (2) As used in this section, the term "park entrance fees"
