5 **Amendment (with title amendment)**

6 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. (1) Prior to the submission of a state plan to  
8 the United States Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to  
9 Title I, Part A, of the federal Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. s.  
10 7411(d), the Department of Environmental Protection shall submit  
11 the plan to the Legislature for ratification in the manner  
12 provided in subsection (3) of s. 120.541 for rules with adverse  
13 impact or regulatory costs. If obtaining such ratification will  
14 prevent the department from submitting the plan to the United  
15 States Environmental Protection Agency in a timely manner, the  
16 department may submit an initial state plan that meets the

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17 minimum requirements specified by the United States  
18 Environmental Protection Agency, provided that the department:  
19 (a) Submits the initial plan to the Legislature at least  
20 30 days before submitting the initial plan to the United States  
21 Environmental Protection Agency.

22 (b) Requests an extension of time from the United States  
23 Environmental Protection Agency to file a ratified state plan.

24 (c) Includes the following statement with the plan: "This  
25 initial state plan has not been ratified by the Florida  
26 Legislature pursuant to Florida law. Therefore, the Department  
27 of Environmental Protection may provide an additional filing  
28 with the United States Environmental Protection Agency pursuant  
29 to Florida law."

30 (2) The requirement for legislative ratification under  
31 subsection (1) also applies to any other legally binding action  
32 by the Executive Branch of the State of Florida, including but  
33 not limited to, Executive Orders, policy statements, policies,  
34 guidance documents, and rulemaking, related to the  
35 implementation of rules and regulations of the United States  
36 Environmental Protection Agency under Title I, Part A, of the  
37 federal Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. s. 7411(d).

38 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
