House Resolution

A resolution designating March 24, 2015, as "University of Florida Day" in the State of Florida in honor of the University of Florida's exceptional contributions to the state, the nation, and the world.

WHEREAS, the University of Florida is ranked seventh on the 2015 list of Best Public Colleges in America by The Business Journals, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida was ranked fourteenth in the U.S. News & World Report's 2014 list of Top Public Schools, and

WHEREAS, for the third consecutive year, Kiplinger ranked the University of Florida third on its 2015 list of Best College Values which ranks the 100 top values in public colleges and universities based upon high 4-year graduation rates, low student-faculty ratios, reasonable price tags, and generous need-based aid for students who qualify, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida maintains its best-value ranking with in-state tuition of \$6,310 per year for a full-time undergraduate student carrying a course load of 30 credits, which is considerably lower than the national average of \$9,139 per year for 4-year public universities, and

WHEREAS, in 2015, the University of Florida continues to enroll academically talented students, with students admitted

for Fall 2015 having an average GPA of 4.3 and SAT score of 1918, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida conferred its 500,000th degree in 2014, making it one of only a handful of universities nationwide to reach that milestone and illustrating its lengthy history of providing Floridians with higher education and economic opportunity, and

WHEREAS, as part of an ongoing effort to increase access to college in innovative ways, in February 2015, the University of Florida launched Pathway to Campus Enrollment, a program that offers prospective freshmen admission to UF Online with a guarantee of admission as a third-year residential student, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida continues to provide access to education for students from low-income families who are the first in their families to attend college through the Machen Florida Opportunity Scholars Program, which, since its founding in 2006, has supported more than 3,200 such students, and

WHEREAS, using funding provided by the Legislature under the University of Florida's designation as a preeminent state research university, the school has hired nearly 75 top faculty from around the world in more than two dozen focus areas addressing complex social issues, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida Gator softball team swept the University of Alabama during the 2014 Women's College

World Series in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to claim its first NCAA national championship, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida Gator gymnastics team won its second straight NCAA national championship in 2014 in Birmingham, Alabama, sharing the title with the University of Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, in August 2014, the University of Florida reported receiving a record \$702 million in contracts and grants during fiscal year 2013-2014, and

WHEREAS, in October 2014, the University of Florida broke ground on a 110,000 square-foot chemistry and chemical biology building that will allow undergraduate students to collaborate with the College of Medicine and the College of Engineering on important drug discoveries, and

WHEREAS, in February 2014, the University of Florida launched Cypress Hall, a new residence hall that will include the university's first specially equipped rooms for severely disabled students, and in November 2014, the university completed Heavener Hall, a major new classroom and learning facility for undergraduates majoring in business, and

WHEREAS, the University of Florida continues to develop the public-private partnership known as Innovation Square with Signet Enterprises, launching construction on a groundbreaking residence hall and entrepreneurial living community that brings together the necessary elements for students to start their own businesses, and

WHEREAS, in February 2015, Optym, a software and logistics company created by University of Florida engineering professor Ravi Ahuja, completed its move to a new office complex in Gainesville where it plans to add 100 jobs, each with an average salary of over \$70,000, over the next 5 years, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That March 24, 2015, is designated as "University of Florida Day" in the State of Florida in honor of the university's exceptional contributions to the state, the nation, and the world.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be presented to Dr. W. Kent Fuchs, President of the University of Florida, as a tangible token of the sentiments expressed herein.
