Johnson, Ed.D., has served as a 9 distinguished educator for 43 years, beginning her career as a 10 classroom teacher and ending her career as President of Pasco-Hernando State College, and 11 12 WHEREAS, over the course of her career, Dr. Johnson has 13 served in a variety of postsecondary educational positions, including guidance counselor, fundraiser, and administrator at 14 15 the Florida Institute of Technology and Indian River State 16 College and President of Nash Community College in North 17 Carolina, and WHEREAS, in January 2005, Dr. Johnson became the third 18 19 President of Pasco-Hernando State College, and 20 WHEREAS, under her leadership, Pasco-Hernando State College was designated a "Great Place to Work"; was ranked as one of the 21 22 100 most affordable colleges in the country; was nominated for the Aspen Award; opened two new campuses, resulting in five 23 24 full-service campuses to serve the two-county district; 25 increased enrollment by 45 percent; and increased its graduation 26 rate by 43 percent, and Page 1 of 3

27 WHEREAS, during Dr. Johnson's tenure, Pasco-Hernando State 28 College also increased the net assets of its Direct Support 29 Organization from approximately \$29 million to nearly \$43 30 million; raised its operating budget by 102 percent; and added 31 numerous programs, including two baccalaureate degree programs, 32 and

33 WHEREAS, during Dr. Johnson's presidency, the college was 34 reaffirmed by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools 35 Commission on Colleges with no recommendations for improvement; 36 the college's associate degree programs in dental hygiene and 37 emergency medical services were recertified with national 38 accreditation, again without recommendations for improvement; 39 and financial audits of the college and the Law Enforcement and 40 Corrections Academy housed within the college earned perfect 41 reviews, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson also served as the Chair of the Florida College System Council of Presidents, as the Policy and Advocacy Chair for the Florida College System Council, and as both President and Vice President of the Florida Association of Colleges and Universities, while maintaining her membership in the American Association of University Women, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson held national positions, including participant, committee member, and President of the American Association of Community Colleges President's Academy; member of the Board of Directors for the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges; and master presenter at the
