15	any of the 5-, 10-, or 15-year milestones, or the 20-year target
16	date, if applicable, for achieving a total maximum daily load or
17	a minimum flow or minimum water level will not be met, the
18	report must include an explanation of the possible causes and
19	potential solutions. If applicable, the report must include
20	project descriptions, estimated costs, proposed priority ranking
21	for project implementation, and funding needed to achieve the
22	total maximum daily load or the minimum flow or minimum water
23	level by the target date. Each water management district shall
24	post the department's report on its website.
