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Section 1. Section 20.166, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

20.166 Florida Business Information Portal.-

(1) The Florida Business Information Portal is established within the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

(2) By June 30, 2017, the Department of Business and

50	(5) By October 1, 2017, the Department of Business and

53	Representatives a report containing recommendations and
54	estimated costs for the inclusion of local government
55	information in the Florida Business Information Portal.
56	Section 2. Section 215.1995, Florida Statutes, is repealed.
57	Section 3. Section 288.109, Florida Statutes, is repealed.
58	Section 4. The One-Stop Business Registration Portal
59	Clearing Trust Fund within the Department of Revenue, FLAIR
60	number 73-2-977, is terminated. The Chief Financial Officer
61	shall close out and remove the terminated trust fund from the
62	various state accounting systems using generally accepted
63	accounting principles concerning warrants outstanding, assets,
64	and liabilities.
65	Section 5. If any law amended by this act was also amended
66	by a law enacted during the 2015 Regular Session of the
67	Legislature, such laws shall be construed as if enacted during
68	the same session of the Legislature, and full effect shall be
69	given to each if possible.
