7 Section 10. Subsection (1) of section 395.1055, Florida
8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 395.1055 Rules and enforcement.—

10 (1) The agency shall adopt rules pursuant to ss.
11 120.536(1) and 120.54 to implement the provisions of this part,
12 which shall include reasonable and fair minimum standards for
13 ensuring that:

14 (f) All hospitals providing pediatric cardiac
15 catheterization, pediatric open-heart surgery, organ
16 transplantation, neonatal intensive care services, psychiatric
17 rehabilitation, or comprehensive rehabilitation meet the minimum

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18 licensure requirements adopted by the agency. Such licensure
19 requirements shall include quality of care, nurse staffing,
20 physician staffing, physical plant, equipment, emergency
21 transportation, and data reporting standards. All hospitals
22 ~~submit such data as necessary to conduct certificate of need~~
23 ~~reviews required under part I of chapter 408. Such data shall~~
24 ~~include, but shall not be limited to, patient origin data,~~
25 ~~hospital utilization data, type of service reporting, and~~
26 ~~facility staffing data. The agency may not collect data that~~
27 ~~identifies or could disclose the identity of individual~~
28 ~~patients. The agency shall utilize existing uniform statewide~~
29 ~~data sources when available and shall minimize reporting costs~~
