10 (e) The notice to an individual with respect to a breach  
11 of security shall include, at a minimum:

12 1. The date, estimated date, or estimated date range of  
13 the breach of security.

14 2. A description of the personal information that was  
15 accessed or reasonably believed to have been accessed as a part  
16 of the breach of security.
