2           An act relating to trust funds; creating s. 282.319,  
3           F.S.; creating the State Technology Security Incident  
4           Trust Fund within the Agency for State Technology;  
5           providing for the purpose and source of funds of the  
6           trust fund; providing for future review and  
7           termination or re-creation of the trust fund;  
8           providing a contingent effective date.

10   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

12           Section 1. Section 282.319, Florida Statutes, is created  
13   to read:

14           282.319 State Technology Security Incident Trust Fund.—

15           (1) The State Technology Security Incident Trust Fund is  
16           created within the Agency for State Technology and shall be used  
17           in the performance of the agency's duties relating to the  
18           prevention of, mitigation of, response to, and reporting of  
19           information technology security incidents. The trust fund is  
20           established for the deposit of service charges required to be  
21           paid by state agencies pursuant to s. 282.0051(18).

22           (2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351,  
23           any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year  
24           shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall  
25           be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.

26           (3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State

27 Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be  
28 terminated on July 1, 2020. Before its scheduled termination,  
29 the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1)  
30 and (2).

31 Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date  
32 that HB 1033 or similar legislation takes effect, if such  
33 legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an  
34 extension thereof and becomes a law, and only if this act is  
35 enacted by a three-fifths vote of the membership of each house  
36 of the Legislature.
