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- (2) The department, on behalf of the state, shall negotiate and execute a motor fuel tax agreement with the tribe pursuant to this section. The agreement must:
 - (a) Be conditioned upon ratification by the Legislature.
- (b) Authorize the refund of motor fuel taxes paid by the tribe on the sale of motor fuels by any on-reservation retail operation owned by the tribe.
- (c) Require the tribe to sell motor fuels at the prevailing retail price.
- (d) Require the tribe to adopt a tribal tax on the sale of motor fuels.
- (e) Require the tribe to use the revenue from the refund of motor fuel taxes paid by the tribe as set forth in paragraph (b) exclusively for the construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of roads, streets, parking facilities, and bridges on the reservation.
- (f) Remove the financial responsibility of the state and local governments for activities performed by the tribe pursuant to paragraph (e).
 - (3) The agreement may provide for recordkeeping.
 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
