A bill to be entitled

An act relating to prejudgment interest; creating s. 55.035, F.S.; requiring a court to include interest on economic damages and costs in the final judgment of a negligence action as a result of a personal injury; specifying the date from which interest accrues; providing applicability; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 55.035, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

which a plaintiff recovers economic damages as the result of a personal injury, the court shall include in the final judgment interest on each component of economic damages. Such interest accrues from the date of the loss of an economic benefit or payment made by the plaintiff. If the plaintiff recovers costs, the court shall include in the final judgment interest on such costs beginning on the first day of the month immediately following the month in which costs were paid. The rate of interest applicable to this section is the rate established pursuant to s. 55.03.

Section 2. This act applies to causes of action which accrue on or after the effective date of the act.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
